A **Proxy Form** is a document used by church members who cannot attend the AGM but who authorise another person (the **proxy**) to act on their behalf (i.e. to vote for them on issues that arise during the meeting).

<u>Please note</u>: A proxy **cannot** vote for any of the formal elections (i.e. the church wardens, parish councillors, or synod representatives). Only those present at the AGM can vote for church officials.
